

Attachment 1: Labour hire policies by industry classification

Because labour hire organisations service and provide labour across multiple industries, they will have a different policy for every industry they operate in. For example, an organisation that provides labour hire to manufacturing and construction will have two policies, one for each industry. As a result, the total number of policies will not be indicative of the true number of labour hire organisations due to duplicates.

In order to get a better idea of actual business numbers, policies with less than \$15,000 worth of declared wages paid in 2015/16 were excluded from Table 1. Labour Hire companies regularly pool all of their premium in one industry to minimise premium paid by them.
