Workplace Health and Safety Queensland (WHSQ) has been informed of an alleged work health and safety issue at

The work health and safety issue is workers are being exposed to mould.

WHSQ has reviewed the information provided in relation to this matter in conjunction with the [National Work Health and Safety Compliance and Enforcement Policy 2011](#). Based on this review, WHSQ has determined that it does not intend to conduct an investigation of this/these issue/s raised at this stage. However WHSQ may reverse this decision at any stage if additional, relevant information emerges.

In light of this issue being raised with WHSQ and considering your duties under the [Work Health and Safety Act 2011](#), it is recommended that you conduct an assessment of the issue/s raised to determine whether you are meeting all statutory work health and safety requirements. You are encouraged to consult your workforce about the most appropriate way to manage the issue/s raised.

Section 17 of the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011* requires a person (with a defined duty) to ensure health and safety through risk elimination, or risk minimisation if elimination is not reasonably practicable. The [How to manage work health and safety risks Code of Practice 2011](#) (the Code) provides information to assist duty holders to eliminate and/or minimise health and safety risks in their workplace. The Code is available from the WHSQ website at [www.worksafe.qld.gov.au](http://www.worksafe.qld.gov.au).

You are encouraged to adopt the risk management approach set out in the Code to eliminate or minimise the risk of work health and safety issues at your workplace.

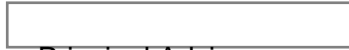
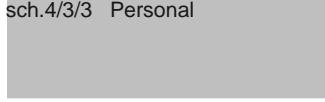
An Inspector may visit the workplace in the future and request details of how you responded to this issue being raised with you.
