Introduction

The Landsborough Hotel is located at the southern end of the Sunshine Coast and forms part of the Sunshine Coast Hinterland region. We are one of the main employers in the local area, employing 36 mainly local residents. We are an active member of our local community, supporting local junior sporting teams and events including the local state primary school Parents & Citizens Association.

The introduction of a part-day public holiday on Christmas Eve will have the following impacts on my business:

Additional wages costs

We envisage significant additional wage costs. These costs would not be recouped as we would not be able to increase our prices for part of a trading day. This would put more financial stress on the business.

We have functions booked in for this day, as these have already been quoted and confirmed, we have not factored in the costing for staff public holiday rates. Most of these functions would be run at a loss because of this.

Reduced hours for employees

We would need to assess whether to reduce the hours of our casual employees and rely more on our salaried staff and management.
